

**VILLAGE OF WESTON, WISCONSIN
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-021**

- A RESOLUTION,** to temporarily lower the speed limit on Northwestern Avenue from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour during the 2019 construction season;
- WHEREAS,** the City of Wausau is reconstructing Townline Road from Grand Avenue to East Hill Drive in 2019; and
- WHEREAS,** Marathon County is reconstructing Townline Rd (CTH N) from East Hill Drive to CTH X in 2019; and
- WHEREAS,** trucks for the Kraft Foods Plant will be detoured around the construction project to access the plant located at the southeast corner of Townline Rd (CTH N) and Northwestern Avenue in Wausau via Northwestern Ave from Camp Phillips Rd (CTH X); and
- WHEREAS,** the Village of Weston adopted Resolution 2018-032 to temporarily allow truck traffic on Northwestern Ave solely for access to the Kraft Plant during the 2019 construction season on May 21, 2018; and
- WHEREAS,** residents along Northwestern Ave requested to have the speed limit reduced while truck traffic is detoured onto Northwestern Ave; and
- WHEREAS,** lowering the speed limit is a safety precaution due to the necessary stopping sight distance of a semi-truck traveling at 35 MPH as compared to 25 MPH.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees that the Village of Weston will temporarily reduce the speed limit on Northwestern Avenue from 35 MPH to 25 MPH during the 2019 construction of Townline Rd/CTH N by the City of Wausau and Marathon County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the speed limit will be set at 35 MPH once Northwestern Ave is no longer utilized as a truck route detour or by October 1, 2019, whichever occurs first.
